**Abstract guidelines:** Abstracts must be no more than 300 words and succinctly describe the research background, objectives, approaches, and key results or discuss on-going project activities and expected results. Abstracts should not contain bullet points or numbered lists. Standard abbreviations may be used without definition and please spell out any acronyms used in the abstract. *Your name, affiliation, other authors, and other related information will be requested.* Do not include references in the abstract. *Please Use this link: <https://forms.office.com/r/gBbHtUT1cN> to submit abstract.*

The final poster should be no larger than of 36"x 48". The BioPEC Center will provide a supports and easels to display your poster during the symposium.
